

**GODWANA PRIVACY AND SCHOOL BRIEFING**

Keep geography data scoped. Make sources and progress reviewable.

This short brief describes which Godwana data is created in a school context and how content, roles, and visibility are organized.

ACCOUNTS ROLES PRODUCT DATA SOURCES**Accounts and roles**

- Godwana uses SteadyGo accounts for learners, teachers, and organizations.
- Class, organization, and regional roles are represented through shared administration.
- Product access, assignments, and classroom context remain controllable per app.

Learning and map data

- Saved places, map views, answers, and learning progress belong to the Godwana surface.
- Assignments can include submissions, evidence, and tagged weak areas.
- Teachers see only data allowed by their classroom and role context.

Content and sources

- Learning objects and lessons are versioned so changes remain reviewable.
- Sources, translations, visibility, and review status can be attached to content.
- Organizations and regions can manage content within their permitted scope.

School use

- Suitable as a companion brief for pilots, parent information, and internal review.
- Godwana runs in the browser and can be evaluated without installation.
- Additional agreements such as DPAs, TOMs, and school privacy rules remain separate.

Which data is product-specific?

- Saved places, map views, and settings
- Quiz and review responses with completion status
- Lessons, progress, and regional weak areas
- Class assignments, submissions, and linked evidence
- Authored learning objects, versions, sources, and translations
